Lines of accountability

The overseas lecturers will have visiting lecturer appointments with the University. Their immediate supervisors will be programmes coordinators. The lecturers will also work closely with campus in charges.

Remuneration

These are volunteer positions, but ZACU will provide housing for overseas lecturers.

Requirements

- Applicants must be authorities in their fields with master degrees or better from any reputable University.
- Applicants must have some years of University Senior Secondary School full-time teaching and research experience with ability to initiate and supervise research projects.
- Administrative experience will be an advantage.
- Successful applicants must be able to give academic and professional leadership in their fields.
- Evidence in terms of certificates and practical demonstration of Computer literacy is required.
